**Whitefield, NH:** Explore-Learn-Create! The 2019 Futures Summer Camp program is open to students entering grades 7-9 both from WMRSD and outside WMRSD. One of the goals of this program is to offer a quality summer programs to “middle school age” students who don’t seem to have as many camp opportunities in the North Country. We are excited to offer 16 camp sessions geared toward the exploration of various career paths, improvement of athletic skills, and enhancement of world language (Spanish) and writing skills. In addition, a series of daily adventure trips will be offered. The camp season will run from June 24<sup>th</sup> – July 25<sup>th</sup>.

This is a great opportunity to spend quality time with the White Mountains Regional Staff during this 4-week program. Camp runs from 8:00am to 12:00pm, Monday through Thursday. Transportation is available via Berry Transportation at Shaw’s in Lancaster (7:20 am) and the Common in Whitefield (7:40 am). Students must be picked up between 12:00 pm and 12:15 pm, or they may ride the bus after camp to either Lancaster or Whitefield to be picked up at the same locations.

With the assistance of Rob Scott (CTE Director), Mike Cronin (Whitefield School Principal), and Dr. Marion Anastasia (Superintendent) securing funding, in-district campers can attend these weekly camps at no cost. There is a small camp fee for the sports camps and trip camp (assistance is available for those camps too). So as you can see, this is a great opportunity for your son or daughter to EXPLORE, LEARN and CREATE this summer!

Starting May 1<sup>st</sup>, registration is open to both in-district and out-of-district students. Space is limited, so sign up today!
